Our Favorite Charities:

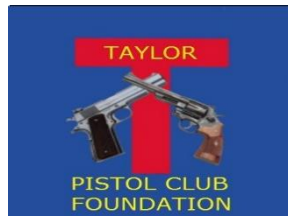
